Applicant/Organisation:

Have continuing funding to buy basic essential food. Anyone can collect these as they wish. People are encouraged to take only what is necessary for themselves and their family so that there is plenty for everybody.

Benefit to the Community:

It will help people cope with considerable rising living costs and hopefully prevent some emergency driving to Duns for everyday food items; so saving fuel costs which would increase living expenses and be environmentally negative.
