Applicant/Organisation:

Berwickshire Agricultural Show 2024: The objective and spirit of the Association is the advancement of Agriculture, the improvement of Stock, the encouragement of those arts with which Agriculture, Industry and the Rearing of Stock are associated, and the promotion of the Agricultural, Manufacturing and Pastoral interests generally. The means to be employed for these ends shall include the holding of an annual agricultural show at Mainsgate Park, Duns and provision of service to the recipients of Long Service Awards within the Agricultural Community.

Reason for Application:

We will use it to part fund the cost of tentage, rosettes, trophy engraving, judges expenses, cataloguing, insurance and advertising for the Industrial Tent at the 2024 show.

Benefit to the Community:

There are many exhibitors in the Industrial section that come from the Lammermuir district which gives them an opportunity to showcase their stick dressing and make and bake skills, whilst being able to interact with other local exhibitors. There is also a charitable class every year, this year it is premature baby beanie hats to be donated to the BGH.

The Industrial section makes a contribution of £800 towards the costs associated with their section, however the remainder is un-funded. The total tent cost for this section is £2076, while the additional sundries (listed above) total £1115. The total cost of this section has risen considerably to £3131, and as mentioned above, the Industrial section contributes £800 which leaves £2131 un-funded - 47% grant requested. Attending the Show would become unobtainable for the Industrial Section should they have to fund all their costs.

Disability Provisions:

The Industrial Section has a range of classes to suit all ages and abilities. There are classes for the skilled baker, novice flower arranger, specific youth classes and a class to benefit charity. There are no restrictions on who can enter the classes and entries from all abilities are encouraged.

While the field is managed as a grass field, it is relatively accessible for those with disabilities. Disabled parking space is available on the field, and all activities on the showfield are accessible for wheelchair users and those with sight/hearing/hidden disabilities. Disabled bathrooms are also provided on the field.
